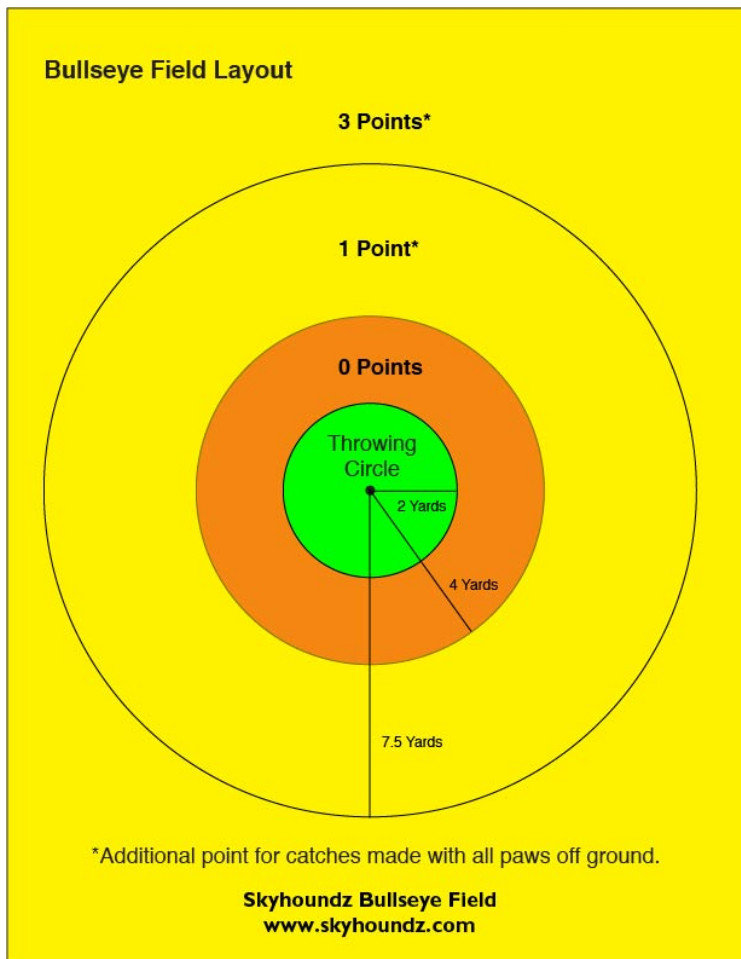


FRISBEE BULLSEYE COMPETITION RULES

Bullseye is a fast-paced circular canine disc game. Scoring zones and field dimensions are shown in the graphic. Teams (thrower and dog) may use **two discs** to complete throws in any direction. **Both the thrower and the canine must be within the throwing circle before time commences.** Thereafter, the thrower and canine may move freely about the field to catch and/or retrieve discs. **All throws must be made from within the throwing circle.** Competitors receive **one minute** to score points. Scoring is as depicted in the graphic.

Bullseye Field Set-Up An open grassy area free of obstacles with concentric 4, 8, and 15-yard diameter circles. Field may be modified to half a circle.

Bullseye Tie-Breaker If there is a tie for first, second, or third place, the tie will be broken by the following criteria: 1) The team with the fewest total throws, 2) A Face-off round with each team receiving one Bullseye throw. The dog making the higher scoring catch will be declared the victor. If

the teams are still tied after each has made one throw, Face-off continues until one dog makes a higher scoring catch than the other. Judges will permit the competitors to rest their dogs as necessary.

Types of Discs Any type of plastic or cloth disc/Frisbee may be used provided the item is safe for dog use.
